Eligibility / Requirements

Any dependent child of an active member in good standing of I.B.E.W. Local 150 and not engaged in prohibitive employment is eligible to receive a scholarship. Children of members include foster children, stepchildren and adopted children. Children of deceased and disabled members shall also be eligible provided that the member fulfilled the four year "good standing" minimum requirement. A member retired from the I.O. is not an active member.

Minimum eligibility requirements are:

1. Each recipient must be a High School graduate or have completed a G.E.D. by completion of the current school year.
2. Each recipient must be provisionally accepted as a full-time student into an accredited college or university, community college or professional vocational program.
3. All applicants must submit official transcripts from high schools, also from any college or other educational program. Copies of transcripts will be accepted. Previous applicants must submit the most recently completed semester transcript.
4. An essay of 300 to 500 words on the following topic:

How has growing up in a union household impacted you?

Please note: Scholarships cannot be used for recognized building trade's apprenticeship or training programs.

Scholarship awards must be used for educational purposes only. The maximum amount awarded will be \$500.00. Any unused portion of awarded scholarships shall be returned to the scholarship committee.

All scholarship winners are required to attend the August 5, 2026, Union Meeting as a final requirement to obtain their Scholarship Award. There will be a reminder of this in your Congratulations letter.

Scholarship Award checks shall be paid to the Bursar of the accredited institution, college, or university only.

International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 150 reserves the right to alter, suspend, or cancel this scholarship at any time. All scholarship winners will receive awards granted prior to any changes.
