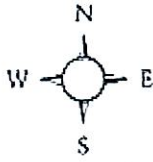
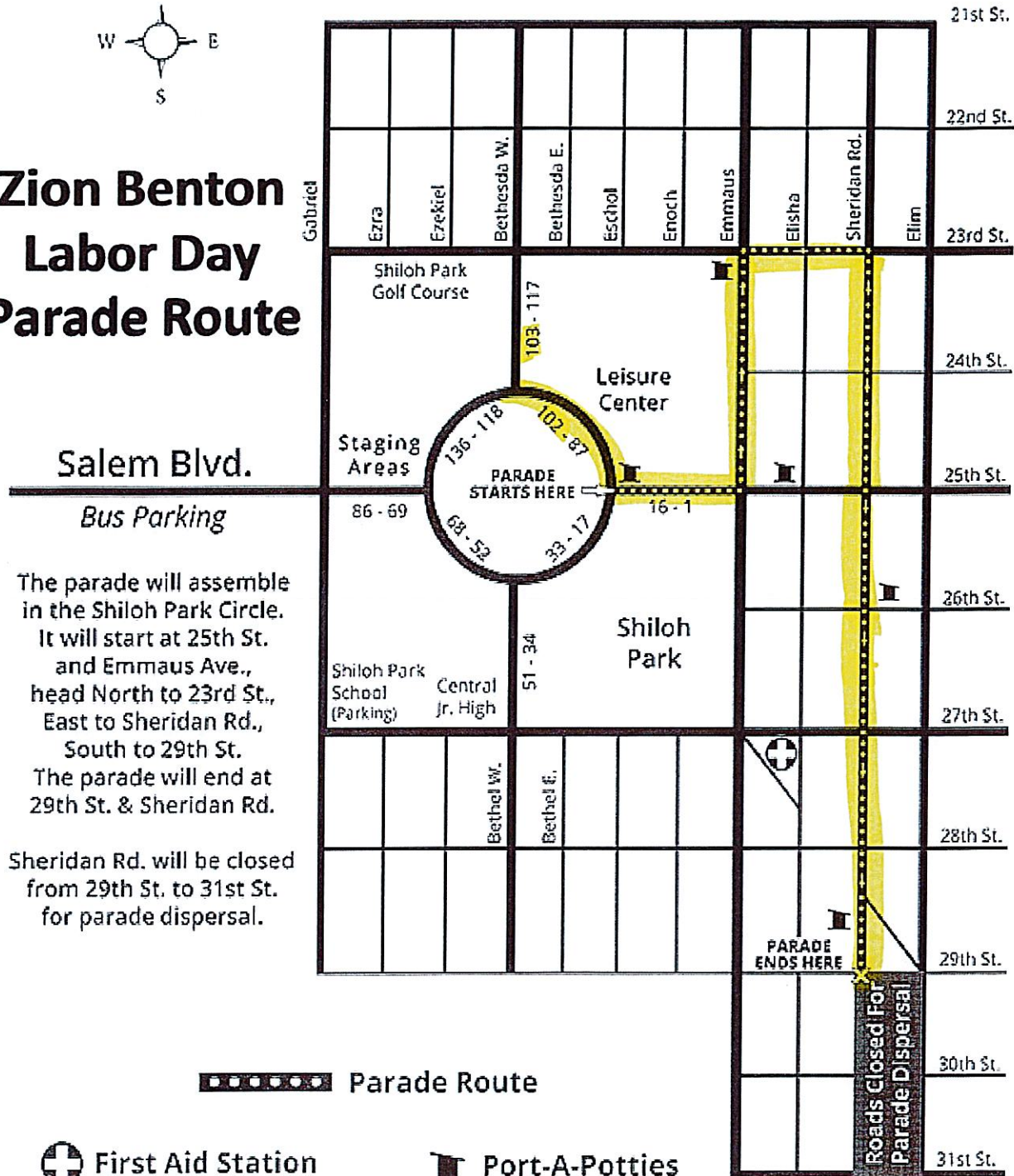

## Zion Benton Labor Day Parade Route



The parade will assemble in the Shiloh Park Circle. It will start at 25th St. and Emmaus Ave., head North to 23rd St., East to Sheridan Rd., South to 29th St. The parade will end at 29th St. & Sheridan Rd.

Sheridan Rd. will be closed from 29th St. to 31st St. for parade dispersal.

## DIRECTIONS FOR PARADE PARTICIPANTS

### PARADE LINEUP NUMBERS 87-102

We take pride in our Parade and are happy that you will participate with us. This note is intended to make your experience here as trouble-free and pleasant as possible. If you take the time to make yourself and your people aware of these suggestions, we believe everything will run more smoothly.

Traffic on Parade Day in Zion can be quite confusing. If you enter "2500 Dowie Memorial Drive, Zion IL" in your GPS, your guidance should bring you to Dowie Memorial Drive by way of either Bethel Boulevard, Bethesda Boulevard or Salem Boulevard. Once you have arrived at one of these boulevards, turn LEFT and proceed around Dowie Memorial Drive to your number between Bethesda Blvd. and Shiloh Blvd. Your lineup number will be located on the right hand side along the curb.

**At the end of the parade (at 29<sup>th</sup> St. & Sheridan Road), you can either proceed west on 29<sup>th</sup> street back to your original lineup location/staging area, or...proceed south on Sheridan Road to 31<sup>st</sup> Streets. This will alleviate a 'bottle-neck' at the end of the parade. Please inform your people that pick-up of children, etc. can take place at your original staging area (preferably) or at the parade's end.**

Parking for busses and other vehicles is available on either the south lane of Salem Boulevard, west of Gabriel Ave., or on Sheridan Road between 29<sup>th</sup> St. & 31<sup>st</sup> St. These are the most convenient ways to get loaded and be on your way. Again, to avoid post-parade traffic, just try to get south or west of the parade's end as quickly as possible.
